



6 Day / 6 Night Yongala Expedition Itinerary 03 – 09 NOV 2020

Join Spirit of Freedom for a rare opportunity to explore the offshore Coral Sea Reefs & Australia’s largest shipwreck, SS Yongala. Departing from Townsville, this expedition will have a full day of diving on the SS Yongala, which is arguably one of the best shipwrecks in the world. Making our way north to Cairns, the next few days will be spent in the Coral Sea East of Cairns. These reefs are seldom visited by any boats, and many of the hundreds of reefs in the region, are yet to be fully explored. While offering incredible diving, these expeditions are of an exploratory nature and are suitable only for experienced divers. **Opportunity to do up to 25 dives.**

Depart Townsville: Tuesday 03 NOV 2020 at 10.00
Return Cairns: Monday 09 NOV 2020 at 07.30

- Day 1: Departure from Townsville Wharf at 10am. Travel to Wheelers Reef for the opportunity to do up to 3 dives including 1 night dive.
- Day 2: Travel to the SS Yongala, with the opportunity to do up to 5 dives including 1 night dive.
- Day 3: Diving Flinders Reef. Opportunity to do up to 5 dives including 1 night dive.
- Day 4: Diving Flinders Reef. Opportunity to do up to 4 dives.
- Day 5: Diving Dart or Flora Reef. Opportunity to do 4 dives, followed by overnight travel to Holmes Reef.
- Day 6: Diving Holmes Reef. Opportunity to do 4 dives, followed by overnight travel to Cairns
- Day 7: Arrive Cairns early morning. Breakfast on board and disembark 7.30am.

Diver Recommendations: Diving at the Coral Sea can be considered Advanced Type Diving, and a ‘Advanced Diver’ certification with a minimum 50 ocean dives, 5 in the last 12 months, is recommended.
